Important Exhibitor Information

- One entry per class, per person
- All entries must be grown by exhibitor
- No hothouse grown flowers
- Plants must be BUG FREE, DISEASE FREE & FUNGUS FREE
- Collection of house plants must be displayed in a flat box with 2 inch sides
- Display cut flowers in plain glass jars. Glass jars MUST be used. Mandatory for classes X01-X34
- Mixed colours – 3 to 5 stems
- Single flower on stem unless otherwise stated
- Potted displays, if 12 inches or larger, or heavy, must be carried in and removed by exhibitor, or arranged helper or they cannot be entered.

Judging Criteria

Cut flowers will be judged on:

Form: Uniformity, proper shape, and proper petals

Stem and Foliage: Strength and/or straightness, quality size and proportion

Colour: Uniformity, intensity, clarity brilliance

Size: Uniformity and size according to variety

Condition: Must be blemish, pest and disease free
